FAMILY DUES PROGRAM

Since there has been some confusion on "how much" should be paid under this program, we are providing the following breakdown:

Annual Dues:	International	- \$39.00
	State	- \$13.00
	Club	- <u>\$23.00</u>
	TOTAL	- \$75.00

1st Family member still pays this amount

The 2nd – 4th family member pays the same State and Club dues, but only \$19.50 International dues or a total annual dues of \$55.50. Since our Club bills on a semi-annual basis the dues are as follows:

1 st Family member semi-annual dues:	\$37.50 (1/2 of \$75.00)
2 nd -4 th Family member semi-annual dues:	\$27.75 (1/2 of \$55.50)

In addition, those members qualifying under the family dues program can also receive a \$10/year discount (\$5 semi-annually) for receiving electronic email.

2007 Lions Car Ticket Contest Rules

The annual car ticket sales competition begins on April 1, 2007. By participating in the contest you may win a free dinner at a fine restaurant. Your sales and the sales of non-members who sell for you are credited to you and your team. Dollars (not stubs) are used to score the contest. Team Captains and their respective teams are listed on the reverse side of these contest rules.

The grand prize will be the winner's choice of one of the following: **2007 Cobalt, 2007 Colorado Pickup or \$10,000 cash prize.** The prize will be drawn at the conclusion of the Carnival, Saturday, August 4, 2007. A drawing will be held Monday, July 30th through Friday, August 3rd, for a \$100 cash prize. Tickets that win the consolation prizes will be included in the car drawing.

The tickets sell for \$2.00 each or 3 for \$5.00. A non-member earns 1 ticket for every \$10 in ticket sales. Ask your relatives, friends and acquaintances to sell for you. *People love the free tickets!*

The club member's contest will close Friday, August 3rd, at midnight. Winners will be determined as follows:

1. All members of the team with the highest sales total who turn in \$150 or more.
2. The ten (10) highest individuals (**sales must be over \$150**) who **are not** members of the 1st place team.
3. Team Captains will win a dinner if their team sales total \$3,000 or higher.

Lion Ron Evans will be the contest tabulator. Your sales should be given to him. Lion Ron lives at 8 Brubeck Circle, Marysville (Rye Twp.). Please turn in sales early and often, to help stimulate the team competition. Put your names on a slip of paper and include it with your sold tickets to assure proper credit. New members will be added to the team of which their sponsor is a member. **NOTE:** Please be courteous and **DO NOT** turn in ticket sales to Lion Ron Evans after 9:00 p.m. daily.

The car will be displayed on weekends at malls, stores, etc. (See tentative schedule on reverse side of this form.) Tickets will be sold by teams of two Lions working short shifts. Sales made during these times are credited to the Lions who help and to their team. **Each weekend's sales are totaled and divided equally among those who worked that weekend.** Please phone **Lion Ron Evans @ 957-2675 or Lion George Askins @ 957-3727** and volunteer to help with this part of the project.

The car committee will select the date and location for the contest winner's dinner and determine the menu, selections and cost. Whenever possible, the dinner is held the evening of the **4th Thursday in August.**

NOTE: Members of the Marysville Lions Club ARE NOT eligible to win the car and /or the cash prizes. Those members holding membership in both the Lions Club and the Lioness Club will be considered Lions and, therefore, ARE NOT eligible to win.
